This term we will be visiting Chertsey Library and St Peter's Church. We will be learning about different types of books, including dictionaries. We will learn about Christianity, the church building and what happens in a church, learning about the life of Jesus and his friends and what we can learn about friendship in relation to being a buddy and a play leader. We will be having a 'school' role play area and learning about schools in Victorian times as well as creating registers, timetables and our own ideal school.
