We have entered the term of illness and are sad to see that some of our children have already succumbed. Please can I take this opportunity to reiterate that Surrey's rules are that if your child is sick or has diarrhoea, they may not come back to school until 48 hours after they were last ill. Also, if your child has a temperature or is generally unwell, they should stay at home. We are not allowed to give non-prescribed medicines (such as Calpol) to children.

If you think that your child may be entitled to free school meals, please ask in the office (in strict confidence). We have a check list that we can look at to see if you are eligible.
